- (8) (e) The veterinary graduates should have obtained the registration from the Sri Lanka Veterinary Council prior to the closing date of the application.
- (9) (i) (c) the applicants should sit for a general knowledge question paper and a subject specific question paper relevant to the post and they will be called for an interview based on the order of the aggregate of the marks obtained for same and on the number of existing vacancies of the relevant post. Recruitments to the relevant post will be made accordingly. No marks will be given at the interview.
- (10) Limited recruitments for Class II Grade II:
 - (i) *Method for the limited recruitments.*–50% of the vacancies of the post of Livestock Officer will be filled from the limited recruitment process.
 - (a) the applicants should sit for a general knowledge question paper and a subject specific question paper.
 - (b) Based on the order of the aggregate of the marks obtained for the general knowledge question paper and a subject specific question paper and on the number of vacancies allocated for the post, applicants will be called for an interview and recruitments will be made. No marks will be given at the interview.

(ii) Qualifications for the limited recruitments.— Livestock Development Officer or a Research Assistant of the Department of Animal Production and Health/Livestock Development Instructor of the provincial public service, with a 2 year Diploma in Animal Husbandry/Agriculture and as a special grade officer or completion of 4 years satisfactory service in the Class I of the Livestock Development Officers Service/Livestock Development Instructor in the Provincial Public Service/Sri Lanka Technical Service;

or

Livestock Development Officer/Research Assistant of the Department of Animal Production and Health/ Livestock Development Instructor in the provincial public service with a four year degree in animal husbandry/agriculture from a recognized university and 5 years satisfactory service.
