Re-instatement of Returnees who were Displaced

Your attention is drawn to Public Administration Circular No. 14/88 of 25.04.1988, No.33/90 of 07.08.1990, No.04/91 of 17.02.1991, No.10/91 of 14.03.1991, No.53/91 of 14.11.1991, No.14/88(1) of 19.12.1991 and No.09/92 of 21.02.1992.

02. Public Officers, Employees of the Local Government service or Corporation Employees who have been re-instated in terms of the above Public Administration Circulars should be placed on relevant salary steps, on the basis that they had been in service continuously, as the situation prevailed was beyond their control.

03. They shall have permission to avail themselves of leave for the period of absence on the following basis:-

- (a) unused casual and vacation leave of the current year.
- (b) unused vacation leave of the preceding year,
- (c) unused vacation leave of any past two years of the service,
- (d) No-Pay leave for the balanced period.

04. The period of No-Pay leave, mentioned in para 3(d) above of this Circular will be counted for pension purposes as a special case.

05. The refugees who returned from India as well as who were in refugee camps in Sri Lanka will be entitled to this concession.
