### **Importation of Vehicles on Concessionary Terms**

Your reference is drawn to the Public Administration Circular No.14/91 of 08<sup>th</sup> May, 1991 and No.14/91(1) of 04<sup>th</sup> October, 1991.

02. Circular No. 14/91(1) of 04<sup>th</sup> October 1991 is amended by adding the following para immediately after the para 2-(2).

“(2)-(a) However any officer who has purchased a vehicle from the Government supplied Department, may be permitted to import a vehicle on concessionary terms, provided that a certificate obtained from the Commissioner of Motor Traffic to the effect that the relevant vehicle is unserviceable, condemned and de-registered with him is furnished to the relevant authorities after three years from the date of such a purchase.”
