REPORT OF THE SALARY REVISION AND ANOMALIES COMMITTEE DATED 9TH SEPTEMBER 1994

The Government has accepted the recommendations of the Salary Revision and Anomalies Committee appointed to go into the issues that have arisen consequent to the revision of the salary of the Middle Level Technical Service (MLTS) and submit an urgent report.

- 02. Considering the diversity of various services and salary structures attached to those services, it has been decided to review the salaries of the services affected by implementing the P.A. Circulars Nos. 27/94 of 1994/07/25, 29/94 of 1994/08/08 and 30/94 of 1994/08/11 on case by case basis.
- 03. Therefore, each Ministry is requested to examine the existing salary structures of Services within your purview which were left out from recent salary increases announced by P.A. Circulars Nos. 29/94 and 30/94 and submit separate Cabinet Papers to the Cabinet of Ministers to be forwarded to the SCC for study and report as a priority matter (an advance copy to be sent to the SCC, Secretary, Ministry of Finance and the Director of Establishments for information and study).
