SALARIES OF TECHNICIANS' GRADES

The Government has decided to revise the salaries of Technicians' Grade (selection grade), Class I Grade I and Class I Grade II of the Labour Grade.

2. New salary scales are shown below.

3. Incremental dates of officers in these grades will remain unchanged and the existing efficiency bars of all officers in these grades will operate at the corresponding salary steps.

4. The salary conversion from the existing salaries to new salaries is on a step for step basis.

5. Entitlement of the officers concerned for Combined allowance and Railway Warrants will be based on "1993 New Salaries" as defined in P.A. Circular No. 37/92 dated 24.12.1992, irrespective of the new salary scales introduced by this circular. Similarly, the rate of contribution to Widows & Orphans pension and Widowers and Orphans Pension will remain unchanged as provided in P.A. Circular No. 37/92 dated 24.12.1992. But calculation of contribution will be based on the new salary of the officer concerned.

6. This salary revision will be effective from 1st January 1995.
