**Staff requirements in the office of the  
Commissioner General of Rehabilitation**

Your attention is invited to the Public Administration Circular No. 5/91 of 17.02.1991 on the above subject.

02. The staff which serves in the office of the Commissioner General of Rehabilitation consists of various officers obtained from Ministries/ Departments/Corporations/Armed Services/Banks/Boards and Voluntary Organisations. Requests are being received to revert these officers who were so attached on the requirement of the Government, to their former institutions. Some Institutions have even withheld the payment of salaries to some of these officers. As a result functioning the office of the Commissioner General of Rehabilitation has become difficult.

03. The Government has decided that action should be taken to provide salaries, increments, other allowances, promotions and other benefits to which they are entitled, if any, to these officers attached to the office of the Commissioner General of Rehabilitation, by the relevant Ministries/Departments Corporation/Armed Services/Boards/Banks or any other Public Sector Institutions from 03.01.1990, the date of commencement of the office of the Commissioner General of Rehabilitation on the requirement of the Government, until the closure of the office.

Please act accordingly.
