02. The entitled for combined allowance and railway warrants will remain on the basis of the Public Administration Circulars No. 37/92 of 24.12.1992 irrigation of the salary revision on the basis of this Circular.

03. If allowances indicated in para 2 of the Public Administration Circular No. 09/96 dated 20.03.96 have been paid from 01.01.96 such monies should be recovered when making payments under this Circular.

04. It should be noted that the payments of the revised salaries should be made by the Departments and Ministries from the allowances for recurrent expenditure made for the year 1996. If additional funds are required, requests for funds should be forwarded to the Director General - Budget of the General Treasury along with the clarification on the basis on which such additional funds are required. Debits should be raised only after ascertaining that there are savings under the votes of the Ministry/Department concerned or after obtaining an allocation from the Director-General Budget. It should be clearly noted that the Director-General, Budget will not grant allocations to cover up excesses under your votes.
