Provision of Duty Leave for two days per month for Chief Officer in Trade Union where Membership is less than 1000 and more than 500 for Trade Union Activities

The Government has approved the grant of Duty Leave for two days per month for Trade Union Activities for a Chief Officer in registered Trade Union where membership is less than 1000 and provided the membership is more than 500.

2. Section 4:2 Chapter XXV of the Establishments Code is hereby amended as follows:

"If officer is released. Union an to be the should have membership of at least 1000 where the membership scattered. and 1.300 where it is not scattered or confined one Establishment or station. In the case of a Union has a membership of over 3,000 two officers be released for full-time Union work. However for a Union of which the membership is less than 1000 but is more than 500 an officer shall not he released full time Trade Union Activities but a Chief Officer of such a Trade Union could be granted a maximum of two days Duty Leave per month for such purposes".
