The provisions in the Public Administration Circular No. 24/93 of 01.10.93 issued on the above subject will be revised in respect of the Members of Parliament and Provincial Council members on the following basis.

04. The above conditions will apply from 20th June 1995 and the conditions stipulated in Public Administration Circular No: 24/93 and Cabinet Decisions will be effective regarding type, engine capacity, value of the vehicle, custom duty, taxes and eligibility etc., if letters or credit for importation of a vehicle have been opened on or before 20.6.1995. The waiver of payment of 25% of the C.I.F. value for the Members of the 9th Parliament who have been elected again to 10th Parliament for importation of a vehicle will be applicable from 04.05.1995.

A similar exemption will be applicable in respect of importation of vehicle by Provincial Council Members as well. However, if 25% of the C.I.F. Value has already been paid it will not be refunded.

- 05. Other conditions will remain unchanged as indicated in Public Administration Circular No. 24/93.
- The agreements to be signed for the importation of above vehicles have been revised and attached as Annex A. The mortgage bond to be signed will be as indicated in the Public Administration Circular 24/93.
- 07. The form to be used for the recommendation to exempt the vehicle from custom duty has been revised and is attached as Annex B.

- vi) that the Member of Parliament/Provincial Council Member shall not, under any circumstances whatsoever, lend, hire, lease, sell pledge, give away, exchange or otherwise dispose of the said Motor Vehicle to any person whosoever or part with the possession thereof without prior approval of the Secretary to the Treasury. Any violation of this condition will render the vehicle to be forfeited to the State under the provisions of the Customs Ordinance.
- vii) that in the event of the said Motor Vehicle meeting with, or being involved in, any accident or being damaged, destroyed or lost, the Member of Parliament/Provincial Council Member shall forthwith report the same to the appropriate Police Station and to the relevant Secretary.

- x) that the Member of Parliament/Provincial Council Member shall obtain a full comprehensive coverage of Insurance for an amount not less than the duty and tax concession granted for the vehicle during the period of five years mentioned above.

- xi) that in the event of the Member of Parliament/Provincial Council Member resigning form his post or vacating his post or is dismissed from his post before the expiry of a 5 year period from the date of importation of the vehicle, the duty taxes etc., waived at the time of the importation shall be paid by him on a prorata basis to the Secretary.
- xii) that the Member of Parliament/Provincial Council Member shall inform any change of address at which the vehicle is kept to the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, Secretary to the Treasury, Director General of Customs and the relevant Secretary within one week from the date of such change.
