Payment of a Non-Pensionable Interim Allowance to All Public Officers and a Monthly Allowance to All Pensioners

The Government has decided to pay a Non-Pensionable Interim Allowance of 10 per cent of the salary to all Public Officers subject to a minimum of Rs. 1000/- per month (whichever is more) with effect from October 01, 2000. It should be noted that the Interim Allowance of Rs. 600/- granted to Public Officers drawing a monthly salary of Rs. 12000/- and below, with effect from 01.08.2000 in terms of P.A. Circular 11/2000 dated July 14,2000, has been incorporated in the above interim allowance of 10 per cent.

- 02. This allowance should also be paid to daily paid employees at a minimum rate of Rs. 47.62 per diem subject to a maximum of 21 days per calendar month.
- 03. In the case of pensioners, an allowance of 10 per cent of the monthly pension should be paid subject to a minimum of Rs. 500/- per month also with effect from October 01, 2000. The monthly allowance of Rs. 300/- paid with effect from August 01, 2000, as authorized by the Pensions Department Circular 4/2000 dated July 12, 2000 should be treated as incorporated in the above 10 per cent allowance.
- 04. These allowances will be subject to review at the implementation of the recommendations of the Salaries Commission- 2000 and the Committee on Pensions which are now functioning.
- 05. This Circular is issued with the concurrence of the General Treasury.
