## ELECTIONS TO PROVINCIAL COUNCILS - 1993 VEHICLES FOR THE TRANSPORT OF STAFF AND MATERIAL

Further to the Public Administration Circular No. 03/93 of February, 22, 1993.

- 02. Your attention is drawn to the following decisions taken by the Government:
  - a. All Ministries, Government Departments, Corporations. Statutory Boards. other Government Institutions including Government owned estates managed by Management Companies and Public Companies where the Government has at least a 50% share should release their vehicles to the Commissioner of Elections in accordance with Public Administration Circular No. 03/93 22.02.1993:
  - b. The Commissioner of Elections will on the recommendation of the Secretary of the Ministry concerned permit each State Sector Organization or Institution to retain the bare minimum number of vehicles required to maintain its essential services:
  - c. There will be no hire charge in respect of vehicles released to the Commissioner of Elections by these State Sector Organizations and Institutions. However, the Commissioner of Elections will as usual meet the cost of fuel, oil etc, of vehicles and the batta, overtime and other allowances of drivers and cleaners;
  - d. Public Companies where the Government has a share less than 50% will in the first instance be requested to release their vehicles to the Commissioner of Elections. a hire charge as determined by the Commissioner will be paid for vehicles so released.

Please take immediate action to implement the above decisions.
